- We wrote a policy paper for **Smart Growth America** on sustainable water and sewer infrastructure, one in a series on revitalizing older cities.
- On behalf of the developer, we secured **LEED-ND Gold** certification for the plan for Napa Pipe, a 152-acre mixed-use development in the North Bay.
- We conducted a management-level review of the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency's "**Guaranteed Ride Home**" program.
- We finished preparing **Caltrain's Bicycle Access and Parking Plan**, which was adopted in December, and **MTC's Regional Bicycle Plan**, which will be adopted as part of the Regional Transportation Plan later this spring.
- Victoria was recently appointed to the City of **Berkeley Planning Commission**. The commission's current focus includes finalizing plans for the Downtown area, West Berkeley and the south side of the U.C. Berkeley campus.
