- **Three new non-motorized transportation plans!** We've been hired to update the Bay Area's regional bicycle plan (through an on-call contract with MTC); update the *Contra Costa Countywide Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan* (as subconsultants to Fehr & Peers); and help Caltrain develop its first bicycle master plan.
- The *Alameda Countywide Strategic Pedestrian Plan*, which we prepared for the Alameda County Transportation Improvement Authority (ACTIA), won this year's "**focused issue**" **planning award** from APA's Northern California section. The award is especially gratifying because the plan was our firm's first project. On a related note, our firm was profiled in ACTIA's latest annual report.
